

6-Week-Workcamp-Programme

in Germany, March-April 2025

Arrival:

Individual travel to the first workcamp in Wartenburg. We recommend booking your travel connection to Berlin or Leipzig and then continue by train.

1. Workcamp

“Culture Kiosk - Fabulous Wartenburg”

02.03.-15.03.2025

- located in East Germany, Saxony-Anhalt
- an old school and gym will be renovated to create a space for cultural events
- discover the old town and help to prettify a place for the community

2. Workcamp

“Inclusive living project Weinheim ”

16.03. - 29.03.2025

- located near Heidelberg and Mannheim in a wine-growing area
- our project partner restores a historic building
- you will work with people with special needs and your main tasks are demolition of walls, then drywall installation and painting

3. Workcamp

“Nature pure with Naturspur”

30.03.-12.04.2025

- located in Rhineland-Palastine, Otterstadt
- our project partner “Naturspur” is active in environmental educational activities
- you will help to expand a wooden playground and start the garden for the new season

Departure:

Individual travel from the last workcamp in Otterstadt, we recommend to take a train to Heidelberg or Mannheim (for bus/train travel) and to Frankfurt or Stuttgart (for flight connections).



Bauorden will pay a subsidy for travel costs of 180€ per volunteer



Travel between the workcamps is usually by train and organised and paid for by the Bauorden



In the workcamps sleeping accommodation and catering is included



In two workcamps you will have access to bicycles



Volunteers are accident insured through the Bauorden during the workcamps



All volunteers receive a certificate of participation from the Bauorden
